

2027 ACQG QUILT SHOW ENTRY RULES

1. Limited to members in good standing as of December 31, 2026. Youth under 18 y/o must be sponsored by a member.
2. Quilts previously shown in an ACQG or other quilt show, may be entered as non-judged.
3. All entries should be completed online through the ACQG website, and ACQG Quilt Show tab. Registrations will be available November 1, 2026, and must be completed by February 9, 2027 (Day Guild meeting) or February 11, 2027 (Night Guild meeting). You will use ONE ENTRY FORM to enter ALL your quilts. Upload a photo of your quilt, when prompted. Fill in all information on the entry form and provide an electronic signature acknowledging that you do not hold ACQG or The Grounds responsible for any loss or damage to items.
4. You MUST turn in one color copy of each quilt photo at the February meetings listed above. These will be used to determine the location hanging in the show. Please write your name, name of quilt, category and size of quilt on the back of the quilt photo.
5. Fees are \$10 judged and non-judged. Honorary members may pay \$5 for non-judged quilts. Charter members do not pay for non-judged quilts. All judged quilts are \$10.
6. If you are UNABLE to enter quilts online, you will be provided a paper form for completion. These must be completed, photos provided, and fees paid by the guild meetings listed above. Please let Katie Metheny or Sue Lee know that you intend to use a paper form asap. (I would be happy to work with you to help enter your quilts – Katie)
7. If you are entering more than one quilt, you will be asked to prioritize each quilt as you enter it. Only about 250 quilts can be judged. When you finish filling out the form for your quilt entry, you will be asked if you want to enter another quilt. If you answer yes, a clean form will pop up for your next entry. The previous entry is saved. When you are finished, you will submit the form(s). At that point, you will be prompted to pay.
8. Quilt description should be limited to 25 words or less. This will be used for the signs.
9. All quilts (except Art Guild display quilts) must have a 4-inch hanging sleeve attached to the top back of the quilt.
10. You will be provided with quilt show labels to be pinned (4 safety pins) to the lower right back corner of the quilt (when you are facing the front) or in the lower left corner if you are facing the back. Please cover your personal quilt label with cloth or tape.
11. The Judging Chairman/committee reserves the right to move a quilt to a different category if it is believed that is a better fit, to change categories for size restrictions to better fit the entries received and result in a more even distribution of quilts.
